

Energy Star Version 6-0 Manufacturers Statement 2020

Manufacturer Certification Statement

Interstate Window & Door Company, a division of Interstate Building Materials, Inc., certifies the below Interstate window models when ordered with low emissivity glass and argon gas fill, meet the eligibility for the ENERGY STAR Version 6.0 program requirements by having a U-Factor less than or equal to 0.27 and the required Solar Heat Gain in each climate zone dependant on the glass configuration ordered.

A federal tax credit is allowed for certain energy efficient windows that are purchased and installed from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2020. This latest legislation retroactively reinstates tax credits for 2018 and 2019 as well as extends the following tax provisions through 2020. It allows for a credit of 10% of the cost of a qualified energy efficient improvement, up to \$200 for windows, not including installation. The qualified energy efficient improvement must be made on the taxpayer's existing home and principal residence. There is a \$500 maximum lifetime credit for all qualified energy efficient improvements. Always consult your tax advisor.
